Kinloch Ratepayers Subcommittee Report: Wendy Alexander

Our subcommittee met on Monday 13th July and the Items for Discussion included:

Henry Hall Commercial Development - The Village progressing well and is on track for completion later in 2026.

Kinloch Community Plan - an update of the KCA Community Plan from 2017 is progressing well. We will meet with TDC representatives this week and will continue our efforts to work alongside other Kinloch Community groups. The draft will be shared with the community prior to completion.

Security Cameras - making progress with regard to installation of an additional camera.

Local lwi connection - ongoing conversations and good relationships being established.

Disability Mats - now stored over the winter and a grant secured to cover the cost of signage for installation later in 2026.

Council Connect Workshop and Local Government Reform - TDC keeping the community informed as they explore all realignment options. We will continue to attend and support workshops as they are scheduled.

Allocation of Developer Contribution Funds - ideally the future allocation of these funds will ensure benefit to as many members of the Kinloch community as possible.

Review of Kinloch Community Structure Plan - A review date of the KCSP has not yet been scheduled. We will continue to request that a review takes place.

Planned Council Workshops on Reserves, Foreshore etc - nothing scheduled by TDC yet but we welcome these when they happen.

Kinloch Stream Reserves -Ross Mc Connon

Johnathon from Misty Acres -Hingarae Road is going to do some filming for a You Tube video of planting of natives he has donated for the Stream Trail. We hope to get this for KCA's use as well.

Totara's Misty Acres is growing for us, will be planted in September.

Bench seats have been progressed, we have a cost for these, plan to have a working bee in August for placement.
